

POLICIES PASSED BY UNLWC BOARD OF DIRECTORS

BIG 10 WOMEN'S CLUB CONFERENCE

The outgoing President and incoming President will be the two people who attend the Big 10 Women's Club Conference. If they cannot attend the next alternate will be the President Elect. April 22, 2015

Set aside money for both travel to and hosting the Big 10 Women's Club Conference (ours will be 2029). September 25, 2013 – CD started for this purpose.

Set aside \$500.00 for travel expenses to the biannual Big 10 Women's Club Conference. February 22, 2012 (Special savings account started for this purpose)

BUDGET

SCHOLARSHIP MONEY FROM FOUNDATION ACCOUNTS (ENDOWMENT & EXPENDABLE): The UNLWC Treasurer and Scholarship Chair are to communicate before the final student resumes are taken to the Financial Aid Office by the Scholarship Chair. The Treasurer (upon recommendations from budget committee and approved by the UNLWC Board of Directors) shall communicate with the UNL Foundation as to how much is to be taken from each account (i.e. Endowment/Expendable) for fulfilling the amounts voted on by the UNLWC Board of Directors. January 27, 2016

EXPENDABLE SCHOLARSHIP ACCOUNT: Open a new expendable scholarship account, which does not earn interest and is managed by the Foundation. April 23, 2014 (completed June 5, 2014).

MEMORIALS: In April of each year, a memorial donation in the amount of \$300.00 from UNL Women's Club funds will be sent to the NU Foundation UNLWC Scholarship Fund for former and present members who have passed away since the last memorial donation, along with a letter listing the individuals. A former or present member will be included as long as the name is brought to the attention of our Club. May 27, 2020

MAILBOX: Maintain a P.O. adding the cost to the President's budget. March 4, 2026

MEMBER REFUNDS: Membership dues are not refundable. (Deadline for membership dues is September 30 – same as Bylaws). September 28, 2019.

CORRESPONDENCE

Corresponding Secretary/President Elect does not have to send thank you notes to the hostess of the board meeting and the treat-bringers. August 27, 2014

INTEREST GROUPS

Interest group members must have paid their dues to participate. Interest Group Chair shall obtain a list of participants in each Interest Group from the Third Vice President. A verified list shall be sent to the Third Vice President Membership no later than November 30.

Note: The February 23, 2022 statement will be moved to the historical list of policies as it is replaced with the revised policy as of March 26, 2025.

PROGRAMS/EVENTS OF UNLWC

There will be an additional fee of **AT LEAST \$5.00** for non-members attending UNLWC events. Official guests of the Spring Luncheon, invited by the Board, are exempt from the additional fee. October 23, 2013.

SPRING LUNCHEON: Motion passed that a \$5.00 late fee on reservations for the spring event be charged. May 26, 2004.

Scholarship winners should be invited to the Spring Luncheon as a courtesy to them and a way of making our program more visible. The Club would absorb the cost of their luncheons. February 21, 2001

It was determined that if an individual came to the Spring Luncheon as a guest and paid the guest rate, that would not change the amount paid for membership. August 14, 2019 – Statement, not motion.

TOUR: The Tour Committee has the option of cancelling a tour if it is not economically feasible to hold it. May 28, 2003
